The Support Panel is a **FREE** service that has been set up to help children aged 8 to 13 years of age who may be at risk of being a victim of crime or be starting to get involved in crime. Many things can be difficult for children which affect how they behave, such as being a victim of crime, losing someone important to them, exclusion from school, bullying, parents separating, or moving school.

Your child might benefit from the Support Panel if you are worried about any of the following:

- > problems making friends of the same age
- > may be using drugs or alcohol
- > keeping company with kids who are a bad influence
- > taking time off school without your permission
- > excluded from school
- > experiencing trouble in school
- > experiencing trouble at home
- > taking things from shops
- > many complaints from neighbours about behaviour

The Panel aims to make things better through:

- > After school clubs
- > One to one mentoring
- > Parenting support
- > Domestic violence outreach service
- > Drama Clubs
- > Sports Activities
- > Health advice
- > Youth projects
- > School holiday activities
- > Young People Affected by Crime
- > Assistance to and from activities
- > Personal development programmes
